Parking Space Contract & Design Proposal Submissions due on August 21st.

Please drop off your Contract & Design Proposal for Mr Vitiello's approval in the main office Monday-Thursday from 7:30am-4:30pm or email to iburnside@capemaytech.com or aelmer@capemaytech.com.

- The Design Proposal must be in color and represent exactly what will be painted in your parking space.
- Any questionable designs will be discussed and evaluated.
- Students who vary their design from the approved Design Proposal may lose the privilege to paint their parking space.
- A copy of the Design Proposal will be kept on file with the student's parking permit information.

Guidelines for Painting

- Only Cape May Tech Seniors who have an approved Cape May Tech parking permit are eligible to paint their parking spaces.
- The student's name is the ONLY name/initial that will be allowed to be painted on the spot.
- All designs must be within the 6" border of the designated parking area of the parking space and not to cover the white lines.
- Students must also leave a 6" border around the designated parking number that is painted on their parking space.

Suggested Paint & Supplies

- Water-based latex exterior paint, to be approved by an administrator, prior to painting.
- Paint brushes, buckets, a dropcloth, stencils and rags.
- Please do not use spray paint, glitter, or textured paint, "Striping Paint" or Roofing Tar, reflective paint, or fluorescent paint of any kind.

Discipline

- Any Cape May Tech student who paints a parking spot without approval or vandalizes a senior parking spot will lose their parking privileges and face disciplinary action and consequences.
- The upkeep of the space is the responsibility of the student. If for some reason the space needs to be repainted (because of graffiti or other reasons), the student must speak with a school administrator immediately.
- If a student withdraws/removed from school due to disciplinary actions during the school year, the reserved parking spot will be painted over with black water-based latex exterior paint and re-issued to another eligible senior.

Prohibited Designs

- Offensive, negative or rude language, pictures, or symbols.
- "Gang-style" tagging.
- Political language or images.
